The BumbleBee Foundation, established on May 12, 2011, is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization born from the enduring memory of our beloved son, Jarren Donatini. Jarren's courageous fight against a rare form of liver cancer at just three years old inspired us to create a legacy of hope and support for families facing similar battles.

After Jarren's passing, my husband Jason and I felt a deep calling to give back to the compassionate community that stood by us during our darkest days. It was in this spirit that the mission of the BumbleBee Foundation was born: to offer the same unwavering hope and support to pediatric cancer families that sustained us through our journey.

The name and logo of the foundation hold deep personal significance, chosen with love and meaning by Jarren himself. BumbleBee, his favorite character from the Transformers movie series, represents strength and protection. The bee in our logo, with wings traced from Jarren's tiny handprints, serves as a powerful reminder of his lasting presence and the shared journey we continue to walk in his honor.

Over the past thirteen years, the BumbleBee Foundation has grown, but our core values remain unshaken. 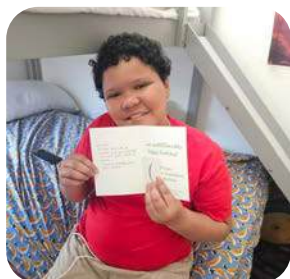

PATIENT AID ASSISTANCE BY CATEGORY



Our Patient Aid Program is the heart of who we are. It's where compassion meets action—providing direct financial relief to families facing the unimaginable. Whether it's covering a utility bill to keep the lights on, offering supplemental income during unpaid time off work, or simply making sure a caregiver can afford a warm cup of coffee during a long hospital stay, this program meets families where they are—bringing comfort, dignity, and hope when it's needed most.



BEEDAYS

Handwritten birthday cards and gift cards are sent to each child, ensuring they feel cherished and remembered despite the challenges they face.



BEEPACKS

Cinch sacks filled with basic necessities are delivered to partner hospitals, where dedicated social workers distribute them to families in need.



HOLIDAY ADOPTIONS

Each child and sibling receives handpicked holiday gifts from their personal wish list, and parents receive gas and grocery cards delivered by our BusyBees.



SPRING BASKETS

Our BusyBees tailor and deliver personalized baskets for each child and sibling. Parents also receive gas and grocery cards.

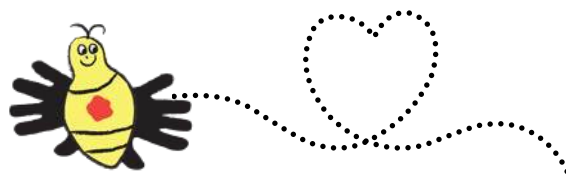
